This includes specific clinical interventions, activities to enhance family roles, such as relationships, communication and functioning that promote the resilency of the individual/family members. The candidate will educate the individual & family members on problem solving and practicing functional support, healthy coping mechanisms, adaptive behaviors, interpersonal & daily living skills. In addition, the candidate will provide linkage to resources and advocate for the individual as needed.

Minimum Qualifications:

Bachelor's degree in Counseling or similar degree and 6 months of experience working with individuals with mental illness, developmental disabilities, and/or addictive diseases.

Preferred Qualifications:
