Job Description

Provide case management to young adults, helping to link youth and families to community resources skill building groups, life skills groups; Serve as a liaison between agency and other partners; Document progress notes; Transport individuals.

Candidate must be willing to work a flexible schedule (mornings and afternoons). Part-time employees work up to twenty-nine (29) hours. Days are Monday through Friday, and occasional Saturdays.

Minimum Qualifications:

Completion of a Bachelor's degree in Human Services and at least one (1) year of experience working with youth and/or families & experience working in behavioral health -OR- High School diploma/GED with three (3) to five (5) years of experience in behavioral health. Must have excellent communication skills.

A Bachelor's degree and experience in working with individuals with mental disorders and/or addictive diseases is preferred.
